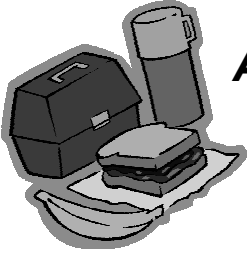




First Grade News – June 7, 2010
